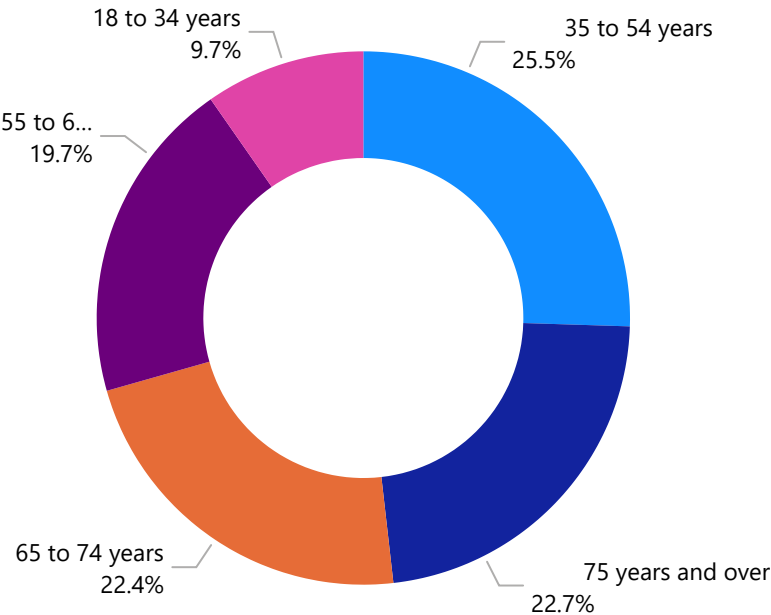

Veterans Population by Age Range(18+ years)



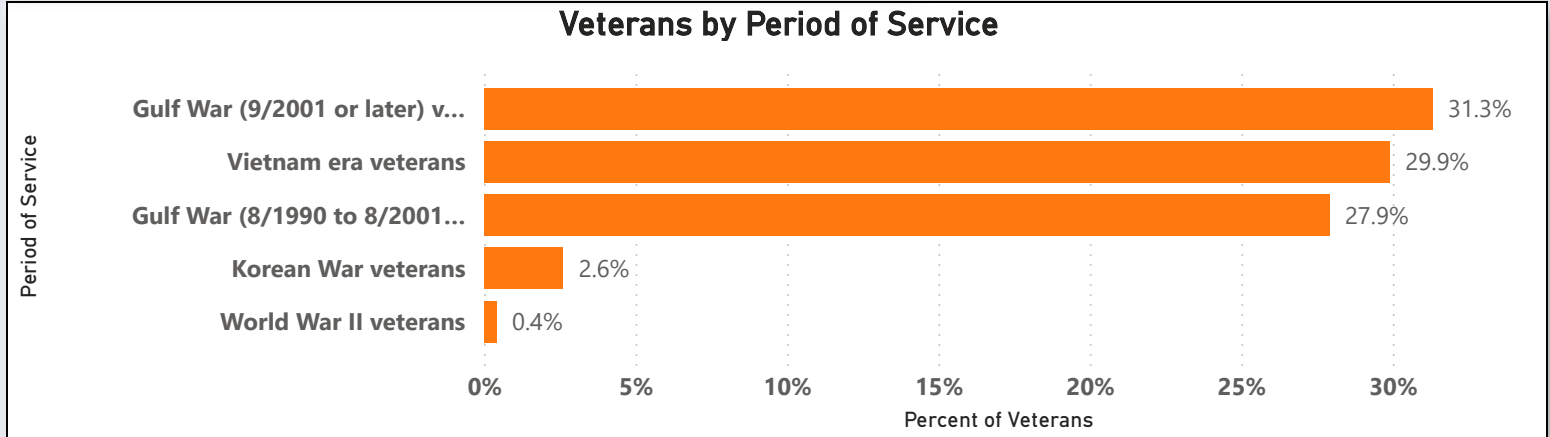

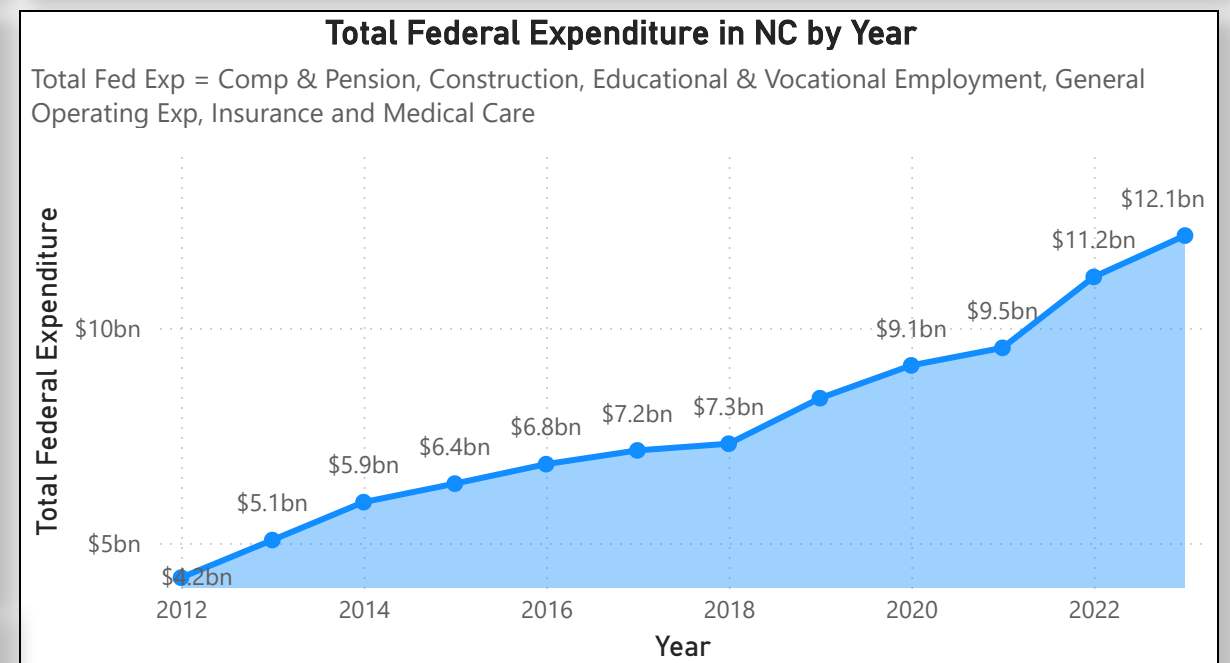
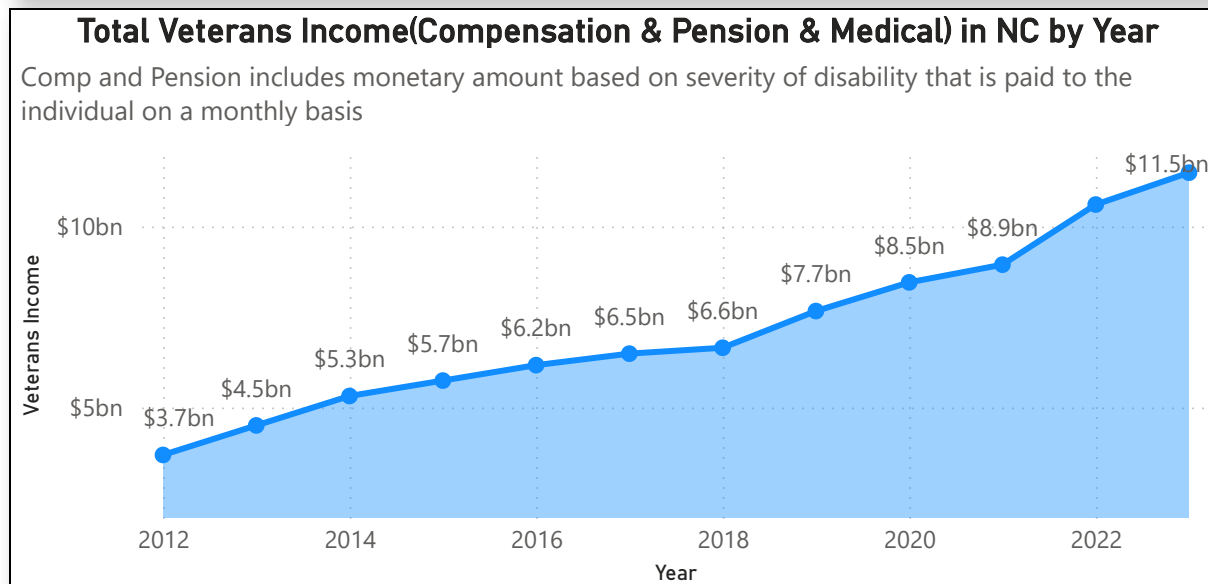
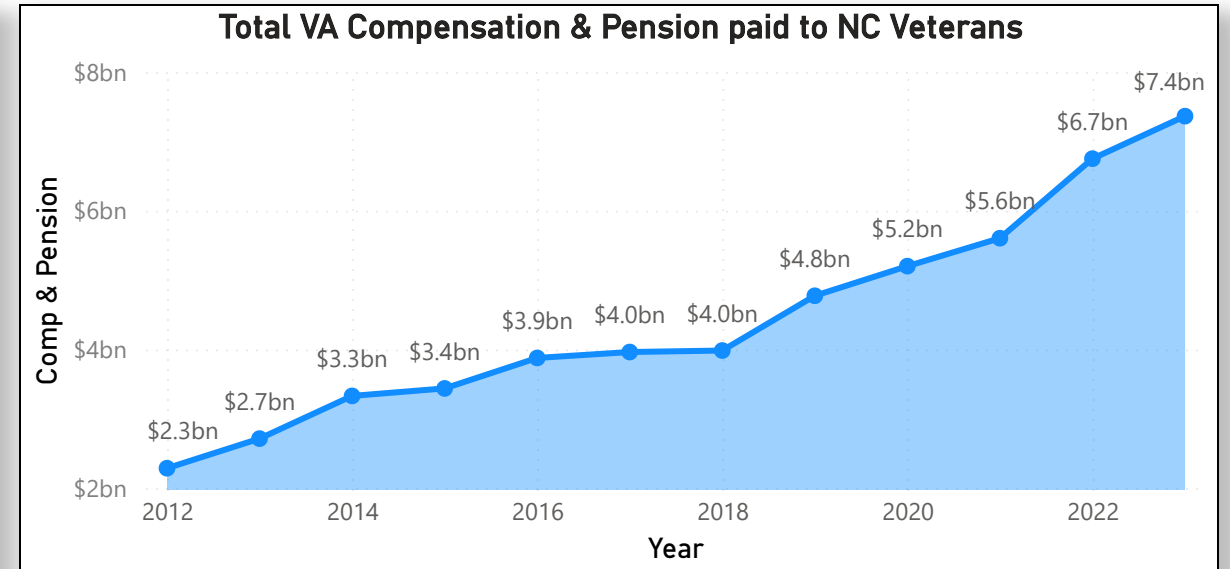
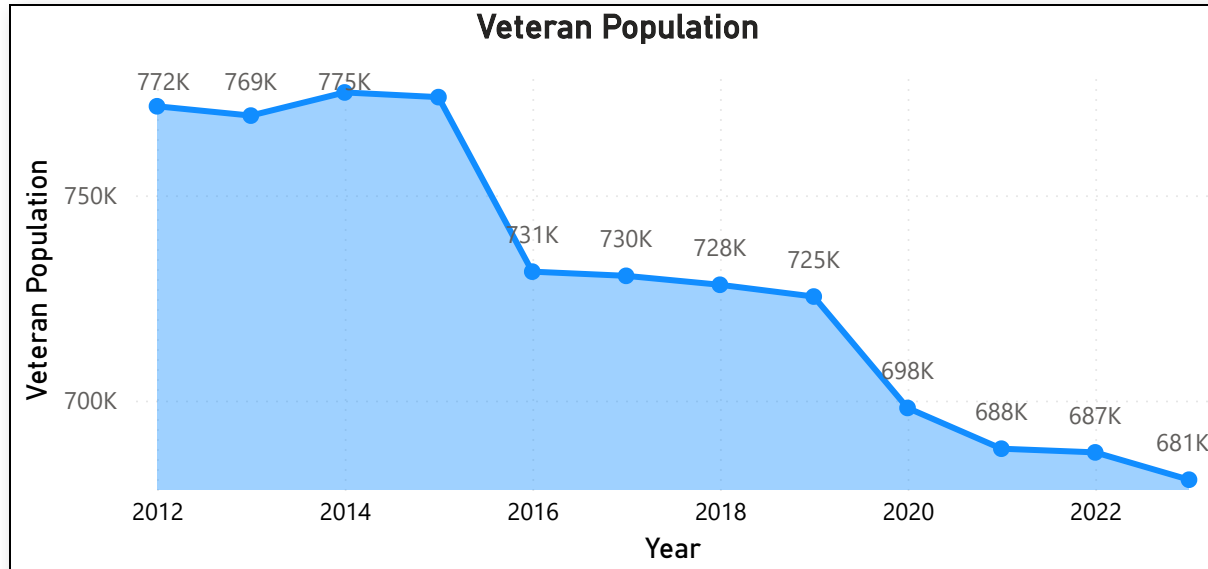

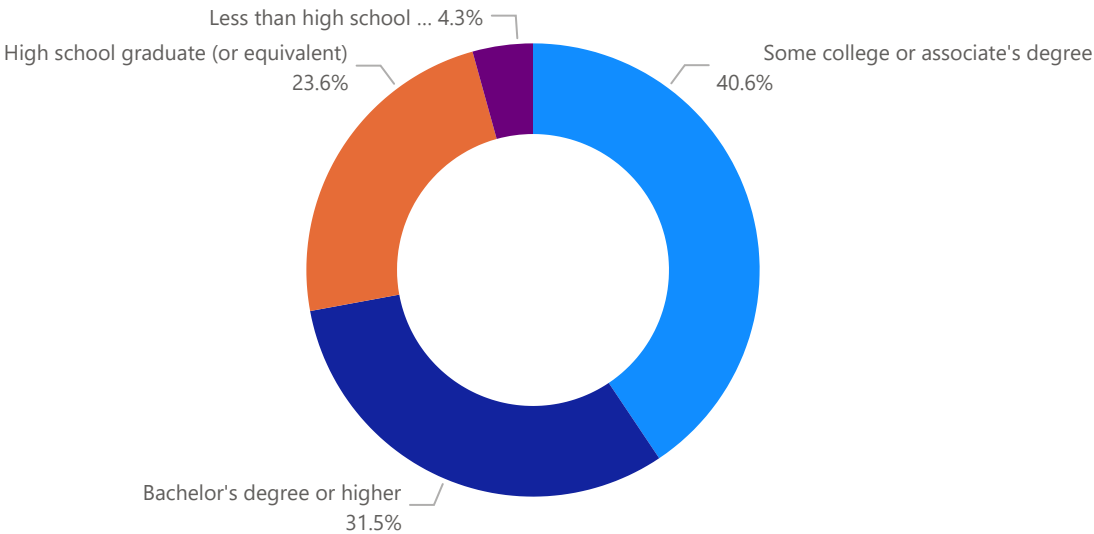

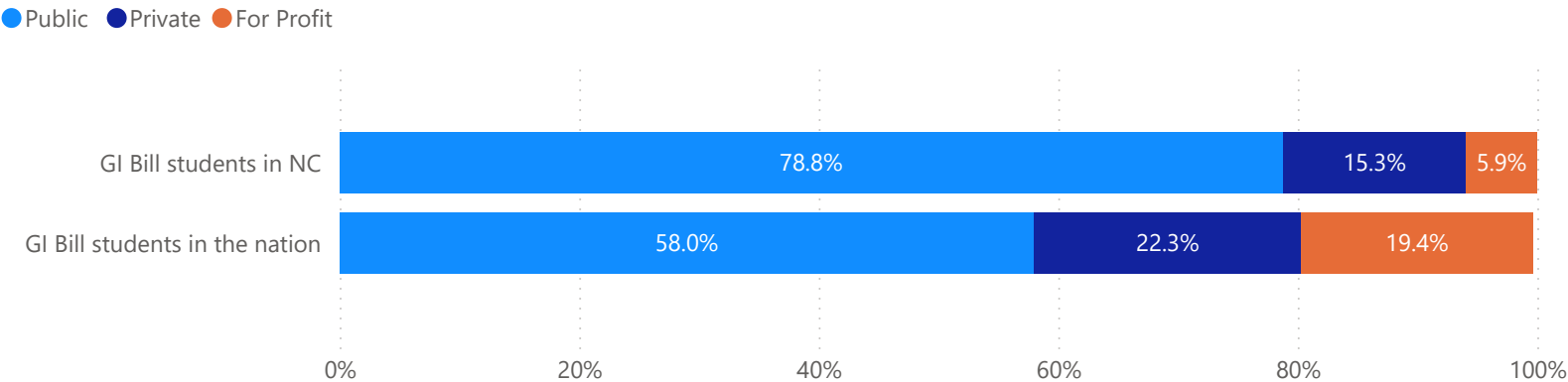
Level of Veterans Education Breakdown(CY 2023)
